As outlined in a previous communication sent on Friday, March 6, 2020, MISO is actively monitoring developments related to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), including information and guidance from federal, state, and local health agencies. Our top priorities are the health and well-being of our employees and stakeholders and the reliability of the bulk electric system.
