

Biography of Tom Weeks

Tom is the Wholesale Market Lead for Michigan Public Power Agency (MPPA). In this role, he serves as MPPA's primary interface with MISO and PJM, the two Regional Transmission Organizations (RTOs) in which MPPA's 22 Member Municipal Utilities operate, as well as the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). His duties include participating in RTO stakeholder processes, advocating for MPPA's interests, and working with the MISO Load Serving Entity and PJM Public Power Coalitions. Tom also tracks and reports on RTO and FERC activities to MPPA leadership and experts and coordinates MPPA's response. Additional responsibilities include strategic initiatives such as new Member onboarding, Distributed Energy Resource opportunities, and Member business model risk analysis. Tom has worked in the electric power industry for over 30 years. Prior to joining MPPA in 2017, he held a variety of positions in functions from retail power pricing and account management to finance and wholesale origination at Constellation Energy, PSEG Energy Resources & Trade, DTE Energy Trading and DTE Electric (fka Detroit Edison). Tom received a BS in Computer and Communication Sciences and an MBA with Distinction from the University of Michigan (Ann Arbor).
