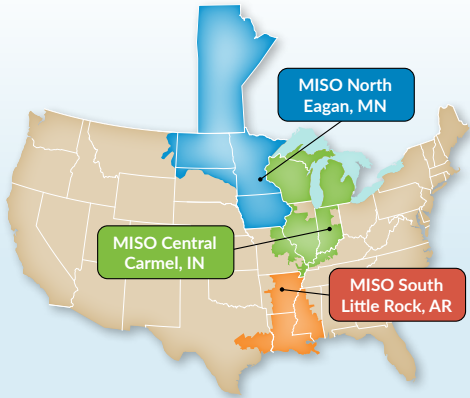

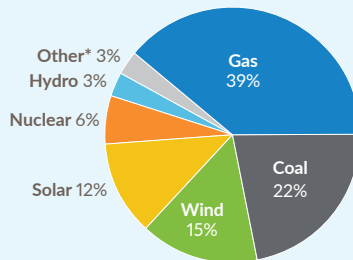


Fact Sheet

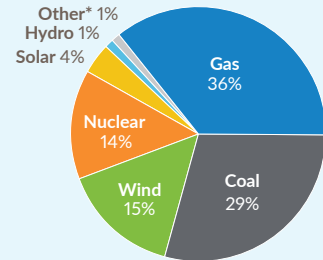
- 1 Managing the flow of high-voltage electricity across 15 U.S. states and the Canadian province of Manitoba
