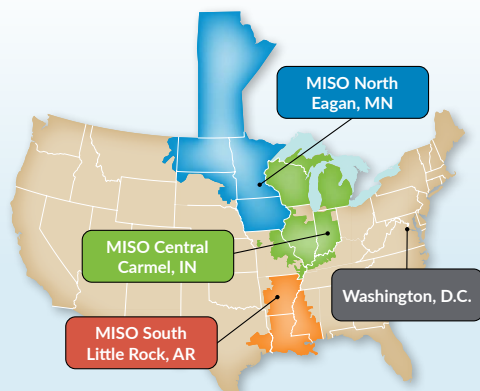

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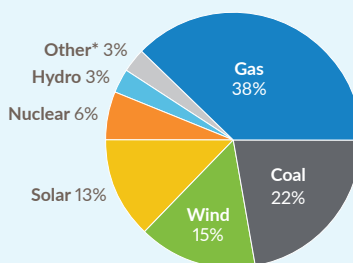


Fact Sheet

- 3 Planning the grid of the future

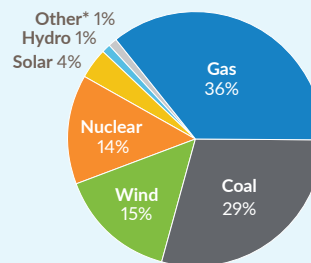
INSTALLED CAPACITY SEPTEMBER 2026
